The Library houses 63 million pages of gubernatorial, presidential and personal papers and over 60,000 gifts and artifacts chronicling the lives of President Ronald and Nancy Reagan. It also serves as the final resting place of America's 40th President and First Lady Nancy Reagan.

RETURNING TO WASHINGTON, DC

In his farewell speech to the nation, President Reagan said, "An informed patriotism is what we want. And are we doing a good enough job teaching our children what America is and what she represents in the long history of the world?" When the Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation was founded in 1985, President Reagan and the Board of Trustees knew that the education of America's youth was of critical importance. Since the opening of the Library in 1991, the investment in and impact of our education programs has steadily grown. In 2015, the organization evolved into the Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation & Institute to accomplish a dual mission of preserving and promoting President Reagan's ideals, vision and leadership. In 2016, we worked with more than 40,000 students across the country, and awarded more than \$1 million in scholarships. Our education work has been the first initiative to lend vibrancy to the work of the Reagan Institute. Nothing is more important to the mission of the Institute than to share President Reagan's example for the benefit of generations to come through education, academic alliances, scholarly work, and substantive, issue-driven forums. Along with the expansion of our work, came our expansion to include offices in Washington, DC. As such, we could not think of anything more important to our expanding organizational mission than the convening of the Reagan Institute's Summit on Education.
